**ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:**

- The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognised University/Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in Foreign countries shall **compulsorily obtain** the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE before taking the admission in the affiliated law college, by applying
  - either through Principal of the affiliated law college as per the procedure
  - or directly in person, to the office of K.S.L.U., Hubli along with all original marks cards of 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> Std & U.G. Degree's.
- A fee of Rs.1,100/- (for non Karnataka) & Rs.6,000/- (for Foreign), is prescribed for obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, which shall be paid through bank D.D. drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, K.S.L.U., Hubli payable at Hubli, drawn on or before the date of such application.

**:ACADEMIC SECTION:**

**The college/s shall admit the student/s only after verification of the necessary documents & eligibility certificate for fulfillment of eligibility criteria, as detailed in the K.S.L.U.-Admission rules. Incase any college makes admission of non-eligible candidate/s to any course, then the Principals will be responsible for future consequences in the matter of non-approval of such admission/s and the Principal is liable for a fine of Rs.10,000/- for each of such admission.**
