1.3 Introduction

The Government of Karnataka has desired to make the study and research of law through systematic instruction, teaching and training in law and to inculcate among citizens a sense of meaningful concern for the law in a system of parliamentary democracy in the State of Karnataka. To achieve this end the Government of Karnataka has wished to institutionalize schooling of laws, thro’ the Karnataka State Law University. Thus, it has promulgated the

1.4 Location
